I. - Introduction.

I.1 Young Planners Workshop: an ECTP-CEU project

The ECTP-CEU (the European Council of Spatial Planners - Conseil Européen des Urbanistes), founded in 1985, brings together 40 000 spatial planners with 27 professional town planning associations and institutes from 25 European countries.

It is an umbrella association providing its members with a common framework for planning practice, planning education, continuing professional development and the definition of professional responsibilities.

ECTP-CEU sets standards of education and conduct for the planning profession; identifies, celebrates and rewards examples of good planning all over Europe, and engages in dialogue with local, national and European government.

In accordance with these objectives, the initiative of the Young Planners Workshop seeks to set out young planner's perspectives and experiences in frame of new European cities paradigms of lack of economic funds.

1.2. - A project shared with the 12th European Urban and Regional Planning Awards 2018.

This Edition of Young Planners Workshop is a project shared with 12th European Urban and Regional Planning Awards 2018 organized by ECTP-CEU with the support of Groupe ADP, the Fundation Metropoli and the Committee of the Regions.

In this framework, the ECTP-CEU Young Planners workshop proposes a topic linked to the 12th European Urban and regional Planning Awards: Airports, Cities and urban development.

The participants of the 2018 Young Planners workshop will be integrated in the ECTP-CEU Award Ceremony on May 18th in Paris, by having a common meeting-workshop together with the Ceremony's participants and Awards winners.

The organization has scheduled a specific session the day preceding the Awards Ceremony for presentations of projects developed by young planners in order to promote discussions and conclusions.

As conclusion of workshop, the ECTP-CEU will publish an e-book with all projects and works developed and presented in the framework of Young Planners Workshop.

1.3 Special Partnership

According to 1.5 point of the partnership Agreement signed between ECTP-CEU and the Groupe ADP Aéroports de Paris *“Le partenariat du Groupe ADP permettra de financer l'atelier des Jeunes Urbanistes Européens qui accompagne le XII^e Grand Prix Européen des Urbanistes par un budget de 5000€.*

Groupe ADP will transfer this amount to ECTP-CEU for distribution amongst participants in support of their travel expenses.

II. - Project description. Airports, Cities and urban development.

The European Council of Spatial Planners has considered the importance of airport cities in the development of metropolitan areas since the beginning of the twentieth century and proposes to enhance planning experiences and prospective through the XIIth European Urban and Regional Planning Awards.

The sub-theme of the Workshop is the Quality of development of airport cities and their role of cultural and functional integration. This will lead to the presentation of projects or research, and/or papers on the following perspectives:

1. Airport City strategic planning in its relations with the Region and the Metropolis, both on the functional and cultural level through its landscape.
2. Airport City and smart mobility, from the nearby to the regional area.
3. Consideration of energy efficiency, reduction of consumption, reduction of the carbon balance, in the development of the Airport City.

1 Strategic planning

- Quality and innovation in the Planning process between achievements and goals.
- How hurdles were overcome during the process.
- Adapting to planning policies and citizen participation development leading to better efficiency in the planning process.
- Demonstrating the strategic planning efficiency enhancing the economic development and quality of life for the whole community.
- Development of cultural and landscape achievements from the metropolitan area to the Airport City.
- Strategies of spatial development and climatic changes in airport cities.
- Strategies of preserving the environment in the airport cities: reassessing the instruments for the environment management.
- Adaptation of the methodological base of urban planning to the conditions of the actual climatic changes in the environment.

2. Smart mobility

- Demonstrating the role of spatial planning in enhancing the accessibility within cities and territories.
- Enhancing pedestrian & bicycle mobility; public transports.
- Enhancing energy efficiency and better public spaces sharing.
- Enhancing real innovations or new insights with real alternatives to get away from conventional traffic management.
- From the airport door to the city: with regulation to keep a good level of quality and exchanges.
- Development of a concept of smart use for existing free common spaces, green lands and parking areas.

3.-Energy efficiency, reduction of consumption, reduction of the carbon balance, in the development of the City Airport

- Demonstrate the role of spatial planning in proactively supporting the uptake/deployment of renewable/sustainable energy solutions through embedding climate-change mitigation.
- Quality of integration between energy, management and planning.
- Prospective on CO2 diminution in airports and aircraft from the earth to the sky.

The works presented along with the conclusions from these papers will be included in a final e-book.

III. - Workshop format

III.1 Working online

- a) Two audio-meetings are foreseen for comments and questions in order to enrich the final presentations and conclusions.

- b) The blog will be the main tool of work. Abstracts, papers comments and answers will be downloaded after each presentation.

III.2. - Final presentations in Paris / Conclusions

The Final papers will be presented in Paris on 18th May 2018. A follow-up session will be held for conclusions on are also scheduled some site visits.

III.3.-Publication of an E-book is foreseen with papers.

IV.-Rules for Admission

A) Projects led by young people aged less than 35 years. In the group at least half of them must be under 35 years.

B) Projects can be presented by individual submission or by groups of up to 3 participants maximum.

C) Members of ECTP-CEU associations will have priority.

C) Deadline for submissions

Submissions along with the abstract should be sent before 1st February 2018 to be selected.

E) Deadline for selection of abstracts

Submissions will be selected before 15th February 2018/

F) Guidelines for abstract submission:

- author's name;
- short title abstract;
- font size Arial 10,
- 1 page/300 words maximum;

- with no images;
- all abstract submissions should be made in electronic form, identifying the software format used (pdf compatible);
- do not use any footnotes;
- reference format “Harvard style”;
- language abstracts should be submitted in English;
- by submission, the organization has all authors’ rights and full permission to publish abstracts.

V. - Rules for Papers/Final presentations

Papers for Final presentations in Paris will have to meet the following requirements:

- author’s name;
- short title paper;
- font size Arial 10;
- max 12 pages plus images and abstract;
- all projects should be made in electronic form, identifying the software format used (pdf compatible);
- do not use any footnotes;
- reference format “Harvard style”;
- papers should be submitted in English at submission, the organization having all authors’ rights and full permission to publish selected communications.

VI. - Economic support/Grants

Financial support will be granted for travel expenses; up to 200 Euros maximum per person.
